STUDENT COUNCIL DUTIES

Duties of All Student Council Members:

- Attend lunchtime meetings at least twice each month
- Assist with implementation of student led activities as identified by student council to support our school and community
- Set an example of service and school spirit for our student body
- Maintain a GPA of 3.0 or higher with no grades lower than a C
- Demonstrate good conduct and effort both in and out of the classroom

Specific Duties by Position:

OFFICERS

PRESIDENT – 8TH Grade

- Supervises all student body activities
- Presides over all meetings of Student Council
- Presides over student body assemblies
- Represents the student body as needed in school, church and community events
- Reports to PALS as needed
- Meets with the principal as needed
- Meets with the Student Council Advisor before each meeting

VICE-PRESIDENT – 7th or 8th Grade

- Serves in the absence of the President
- Gathers feedback from class representatives each month and presents at meetings
- Provides reports to and collects feedback from lower division classes on school activities
- Meets, along with the president, with the principal as needed
- Meets with the Student Council Advisor before each meeting as needed

SECRETARY – 6th, 7th or 8th Grade

- Takes and keeps minutes of all Student Council meetings
- Handles all correspondence
- Escorts 3rd and 4th grade representatives to meetings and provides introductions
- Meets with the Student Council Advisor before each meeting as needed

TREASURER – 6th, 7th or 8th Grade

- Creates a student council budget with the help of the school Finance Director
- Promotes the school Box Tops program and helps prepare box tops for sending to General Mills
- Organizes additional student council fundraisers as needed.
- Keeps an accurate record of all student body receipts and expenses
- Works with the school Finance Director to report amount of chapel offerings to the student council

- Meets with the Student Council Advisor before each meeting as needed

HISTORIAN – 5th, 6th, 7th or 8th Grade

- Keeps a record of student body activities
- Takes photographs with permission at student body activities
- Maintains the Upper Division Bulletin Board ensuring it is kept up-to-date with fun and useful information
- Assists the parent yearbook coordinator as needed Meets with the Student Council Advisor as needed

COMMISSIONERS

COMMISSIONER OF SCHOOL SPIRIT – 5TH, 6TH, 7TH or 8TH Grade (may be a team of two)

- Monitors student pride and proactively gathers suggestions from students to build school spirit
- Suggests to student council activities to help build student pride in our school and develop a spirit of community among all ALS students
- Plans and implements Spirit Rallies as needed

COMMISSIONER OF FAITH LIFE – 5TH, 6TH, 7TH or 8TH Grade (may be a team of two)

- Leads the student council in prayer at the start of each meeting
- Meets regularly with Pastor Tim and Pastor Chamie to understand faith life events within the church and to obtain guidance in enriching the faith life of our student body
- Helps lead prayer events as needed in the life of the school
- Communicates to the student body where chapel offerings are distributed
- Communicates to student body events of student interest within the church
- Suggests to student council activities to help enrich the faith life of ALS students

COMMISSIONER OF ECO-SCHOOLS – 5TH, 6TH, 7TH or 8TH Grade (may be a team of two)

- Works with the Student Council Advisor to understand our goals for making our campus more eco-friendly
- Encourages student involvement and enthusiasm in making our school environmentally-friendly
- Suggests to student council activities to help our school meet its eco-school goals
- Acts as a campus clean-up chairperson

ADVISORY REPRESENTATIVES

One student from each Homeroom/Advisory will serve as ADVISORY REPRESENTATIVE

- One student from each homeroom/advisory will be elected to serve on student council to ensure representation from across the student body.
